Other features of this home include wood frame casement windows, paired on the front but placed individually elsewhere. Some windows on the porch are fixed. There is a somewhat ackwardly placed room addition at the left front corner next to the porch and another room addition at the rear of the home.

Harry Lilyard, who did not live in Chula Vista, built this house in 1923 and sold it on March 14, 1924 to Jewell and Virginia Connor. Mr. Connor was the superintendent of the Van Riter Grain and Milling Company of San Diego. The Connors lived in the house only a short time before they sold it to Emery F. Bush and his wife, Agnes, on June 9, 1926. Emery Bush was a title searcher for the Union Title Insurance Company. Agnes Bush owned the house until about 1937 or 1938. This house is a somewhat altered example of a modest 1920s bungalow.
