Holly Cleaners was started in 1934 by Eldon Ludvlckson and Jesse Dixon at 436 Third Avenue. It was purchased by Dick Halferty in 1936. In 1937 he got the contract to handle the laundry for two navy destroyers. In 1940 he opened a larger shop at 345 Third Avenue. In 1945, he got a war priority to build the plant at 48 Broadway that opened in Feb. 1946, and added laundry facilities in 1954. He added another building adjacent to it in 1966 for his exclusive drapery cleaning business, the largest of its kind in the county. Richard J. Halferty was born 1912 in Aberdeen, Washington, father owned Pioneer Packing Co., came to CV 1931, served in Navy 1932-1936, married Ruth Holmes 1938, lived at 26 Palomar Dr., had two girls, was City Councilman 1952-54, Mayor 1954, member of the CV Community Hospital Advisory Board and San Diego County Association of Big Brothers.
