

## DESCRIPTION

  - Legal: Ratcliffe Tct, Lot 25

This carefully detailed one story bungalow features a lcw, front-facing gable roof with a double gable facing the street. The eaves are wide with exposed rafter ends and knee braces. The lower part of the right side of the house roof is extended forward to form the right half of the second gable that shelters an open entrance porch. An elephantine pillar on a brick pier supports the porch roof at each front corner. A third brick pier, without a pillar, at the center balances the design. Other details include narrow horizontal clapboard siding flared at the foundation line, decorative vents in the gable ends, and a row of dentils across the porch gable. An exterior brick chimney pierces the house eave on the right side. The front door is centered with a set of three windows on each side. The door and the right hand windows open onto the porch.
