Legal: Country Club Villas, Blk D, Lot 8 This large, one story, stucco house stands on a corner lot. The home features a complex, cross gable and shed, red tile roof with exposed rafter ends. At the front, the building is almost "U" shaped with a small entrance courtyard inside the "U" and partly enclosed by a low wall. A high wall extends from the left side of the house and curves around the corner to meet an attached garage which faces a side street. The wall supports a red tile shed roof that apparently slopes to the rear to shelter an open porch. The garage has a street-facing overhead door. Some windows in the house are large, fixed, and inset; others are casements. A few have shutters. Two large chimneys are incorporated into exterior walls. The vertical wooden siding, visible on the house wall next to the entrance courtyard appears to be an alteration.
