
Schoenherr book draft Chapter 11:

Hubbard Mortuary started Apr. 1928 by J. Warren Hubbard with Galde Porter, moved in 1947 from orig location at 202 3rd Ave to present site at 321 E Street. J. Warren Hubbard died 1943, at his home on Del Mar Ave, was born 1885 in NJ, came to Calif 1915 and worked for George Fitch undertakers in LA, came to CV 1928 when he and Glade Porter opened the Hubbard and Porter Funeral Home. Hubbard became sole owner in 1939. Married Mrs. Jane Hicks Hubbard 1933. Jane took over as director on his death in 1944. In 1947 Hubbard's built a new \$30,000 mortuary at 321 E Street at Landis. In 1946 The City Council approved the Hubbard subdivision on Minot with unusually deep lots, OK for horses. Jane Hubbard died in 1974 at age 81, was a native of Wisconsin and CV resident 50 years. She was member and former secy of the SD County Funeral Directors Assn, the Uptown Business Assn, the CV Chamber of Commerce, charter member and former president of the CV Soroptimist Club. Survived by nephew Jim Reeve of CV.
